Your application was processed on 3/21/18. You should be receiving the packet in the mail today or tomorrow. I have attached the Ammo Vendor License in this email also.

In regards to out of state residents, yes they can bring ammunition across state lines. However, any sales, deliveries or transfers of ammunition in CA must go through a licensed ammunition vendor per 30312 PC. The transportation of ammunition into CA by a CA resident is stated under 30314 PC.
